II. Burn Permit Regulations: Beginning on July 1st 2009, Burn Permits will be issued for open burning of slash for hazardous fuel reduction activities with the dates of September 1st through April 30th. Open burning is not permitted between October 31st and March 1st at elevations below 6400'. Burn time is from 6 am to 6 pm. Burn only when at least 2 inches of snow is underneath and around the burn area. Call Jefferson County Sheriff (303-277-0211) notify Fire Dispatch, and Foothills Fire & Rescue (303-526-0707) before you start and when you finish. Burn in small piles. **No bigger than 8 feet wide by 8 feet in length by 4 feet high with at least 50-foot clearance from buildings, trees, propane, fuel tanks and not under power or telephone lines or over gas lines. All burning shall be supervised by one or more responsible persons. At no time shall the burning be left unattended. All ash or remains of burning shall be checked after the burning has been accomplished, for any traces of hot ambers or smoldering. If winds are at or above 15 mph, no burning will be allowed. If winds pick-up after you start burning, you are required to put out your slash burn. By signing this application, you have authorized Foothills Fire & Rescue to inspect your slash burn area at any time you are burning. Although all specified precautions are taken, there is the possibility that the controlled fire could escape your control. By signing this application, you assume the following costs/liabilities:**

1. You assume liability for all damages incurred to any other person or property caused by or related to the activities for which the permit is issued.
2. You assume all cost of fire suppression should any open fire escape your control or your failure to follow the regulations listed above and we have to respond and put out the slash pile burn. These costs may include any legal fees incurred by Foothills Fire & Rescue in any civil or criminal action, whether in a court of law or otherwise, which arises from the activities for which this Open Burning Permit is issued.

You are required by Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment to include a map to the burn site, plus any gate codes to get into your property.

III. AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE: All applications must contain an authorized signature from the Fire Department of jurisdiction. **NOTE: This Form is an Application NOT the Permit.** This document may **NOT** be faxed or mailed to Foothills Fire & Rescue. **You MUST bring it in to our Administrative Office for approval.** Offices located at 28812 Rainbow Hills Rd, Evergreen, CO 80439. 303-526-0707.
