SPECIFICATIONS FOR RECREATIONAL FIRES WITHIN THE FOOTHILLS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Specifications Include:

- The diameter of recreational fires shall not be larger than three feet.
- The height of recreational fires shall not exceed two feet.
- The fire shall be in approved location or established fire pit/ring.
- An approved method of fire suppression shall be located adjacent to the fire area.
- The use of recreational fires may not be permitted during Jefferson County burn bans or similar local fire restrictions.
- The use of recreational fires during burn bans and burn restrictions requires a fire prevention permit issue by the Fire Chief of Foothills Fire Protection District.
- Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material.
